Comprehensive Guide for Data-Informed Jail Strategies

In January, Policy Research, Inc., in collaboration with the John D. and Catherine T. MacArthur Foundation's Safety and Justice Challenge, released <u>Creating Data-Informed Strategies to Understand the Needs of People in Your Jail</u>. Authored by Senior Project Associates Regi Huerter and Ashley Krider, this comprehensive guide provides actionable strategies for collecting and analyzing data to address the diverse needs of individuals in local jails. The resource covers critical topics such as mental health, substance use disorders, suicide risk, and racial disparities, emphasizing the importance of systematic data collection to reduce incarceration rates and improve jail health and community provider collaboration.



SOAR Webinar on Representing Older Adults With SSI/SSDI Claims

In February, the Supplemental Security Income (SSI)/Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) Outreach, Access, and Recovery (SOAR) TA Center hosted a webinar titled "Strategies and Considerations for Representing Older Adults with SSI/SSDI Claims," which engaged 1,377 participants. This event addressed the unique challenges faced by older adults with disabilities who are experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness, focusing on accessing SSI/SSDI benefits. Key insights included understanding the rise in homelessness among this population to provide appropriate services, strategies for effectively representing them in SSI/SSDI applications, and methods for connecting them to supportive programs and resources.

In March, the latest episode of *Conversations on Leadership*, titled "Steering Towards Equity: A Conversation With Sarah Desmarais and Elan Hope," was released.
